ORDER

Upon consideration of Petitioner’s unopposed Motion for Extension of Time, Accommodations, and Clarification (Doc. # 72), it is ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED.

Petitioner’s reply to Respondent’s opposition to his Motion for Full Disclosure of the Kittie Corley Letter (Doc. # 70) shall be filed fourteen days after the filing of the response. Furthermore, the court will endeavor to accommodate the circumstances described in Petitioner’s motion by affording an additional seven days when setting future briefing deadlines.
